DATA PROCESSING INFORMATION

DAL DERBY National Youth Singing Competition

This data processing leaflet contains information regarding the data processing related to the organization of the **Dal Derby National Youth Singing Competition** to be held in 2024, hereinafter: **Competition**, in order to provide the most comprehensive information possible about the processing of personal data.

Data Controller: the organizer of the **Competition**, Indo-Selera Nonprofit Kft. (headquarters: 1026 Budapest, Hűvösvölgyi út 3; represented by: Krisztina Németh managing director, hereinafter: **Organizer**), operator of the Budapest Musical School performing arts talent development program.

The **Organizer**, as the data controller, makes every effort to ensure that the data processing related to the **Competition** complies with the provisions of Act CXII of 2011 on informational self-determination and freedom of information (Infotv.), as well as Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council (General Data Protection Regulation, GDPR) on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data.

I. Information regarding data processing:

Purpose of data processing: Ensuring registration for the **Competition** and the proper conduct of the **Competition**.

Legal basis for data processing: The voluntary, explicit consent of the data subject (Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR)

Categories of data subjects: **Competitors** applying for the **Competition**, members of groups (hereinafter: **Competitors**).

Categories of personal data: **Competitors** and members of Ensembles applying for the **Competition**:

- a) name (purpose: identification of the applicant)
- b) mother's name (purpose: identification of the applicant)
- c) date of birth (purpose: identification of the applicant, determination of age group)
- d) preparatory teacher, school name (purpose: identification of school, preparatory teacher)
- e) identification and signature of parent/legal representative (necessary for the conduct of the **Competition**)
- f) billing name and address (purpose: ensuring invoice issuance)
- g) phone number (purpose: ensuring communication)

- h) email address (purpose: ensuring communication)
- i) image of the applicant's or legal representative's signature (necessary for the conduct of the **Competition**)
- j) video recording of the applicant (The first round of the **Competition** is conducted based on video recordings submitted by the **Competitors**, therefore, the personal data managed by the **Organizer** also includes the image and voice of the **Competitors**.)
- k) On the application form, **Competitors** indicate the repertoire for the first and second rounds, genre of songs, length, composer, performance formation, and the age group of the **Competitors** (purpose: conducting the **Competition**)

Storage period: **The Organizer** retains the personal data of applicants for 3 years after the end of the **Competition**, in order to inform the data subjects about performance or presentation opportunities, training organized by the **Organizer**.

A fully completed application form is a prerequisite for participation in the **Competition**.

The list of finalists and winners will be published on the **Organizer's** online platforms.

Minor applicants under the age of 18 require the consent of their legal representative for the processing of personal data, as well as for the taking, use, and storage of photographs, as well as audio and video recordings.

During **the Competitio**n final, the **Organizer** takes photographs, as well as audio and video recordings, which may be accessible on the **Organizer's** online communication platforms (especially the **Organizer**'s website, Facebook and Instagram pages, YouTube channel, etc.). The photographs, as well as audio and video recordings, may be accessible on the mentioned platforms for an unlimited period.

II. Access to data and data security measures:

The following individuals have access to the provided personal data:

- a) the Organizer
- b) members of the organizing committee designated by the **Organizer**, staff and volunteers involved in the application process;
- c) members of the jury.
- d) competent employees of the National Talent Program supporting the **Competition** for the purpose of accountability.

The **Organizer** uses their private Google Drive for storing personal data.

III. Rights related to data processing:

- a) access to personal data request access to the data managed by the **Organizer**;
- b) information about personal data request information about the personal data managed by the **Organizer**;
- c) correction of personal data in case of inaccurate data processing, request correction of personal data;
- d) restriction of data processing request restriction of data processing of personal data (e.g. in case of disputing the accuracy of personal data);
- e) right to object (if the legal basis for data processing is legitimate interest or the performance of a task carried out in the public interest GDPR Article 6(1)(e) and (f)) in case of objection, the Organizer cannot further process the personal data unless compelling legitimate grounds for the processing override the interests, rights, and freedoms of the data subject, or for the establishment, exercise, or defence of legal claims;
- f) right to data portability (if the legal basis for data processing is the data subject's voluntary, explicit consent or a contract with the data subject GDPR Article 6(1)(a) and (b)) request the provision of personal data in a structured, commonly used, machine-readable format, and the transfer of personal data to another data controller;
- g) right to erasure of personal data request the erasure of personal data if there is no other legal basis for data processing.

Regarding personal data processed based on consent, the consent can be revoked at any time. Upon revocation of consent, the **Organizer** deletes the personal data. The revocation of consent does not affect the lawfulness of data processing based on consent before the withdrawal.

To exercise rights related to data processing, individuals can contact the **Organizer's** staff, who will respond to the request as soon as possible, but no later than within 15 days.

IV. Remedies related to data processing:

- 1. In case of a complaint related to the **Organizer's** data processing, individuals can contact the **Organizer's** Data Protection Officer, who will investigate the procedure.
- 2. Individuals can also contact the National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information (headquarters: 1055 Budapest, Falk Miksa u. 9-11, mailing address: 1363 Budapest, Pf. 9, email: ugyfelszolgalat@naih.hu; website: www.naih.hu).
- 3. In case of unlawful data processing, individuals can also turn to the court.
